

TRAINING CHARTER

The successful completion of your training, issuance of your Certificate of Completion and attribution of your credits are subject to your compliance with the following conditions:

- Being regularly registered for the research-oriented summer school.
- Being involved in the training with the utmost seriousness and completing all given assignments to the best of your ability, regardless of the level required.
- Signing the attendance lists to certify your presence in class and the actual pursuance of the training.
- Respecting the principle of due diligence in the programme, as outlined below:

Skipping Class

Any absence for medical or academic purposes should be duly justified by a written document (medical certificate, convocation letter from a research director, etc.). The said document should be submitted to the International Academy Lille Hauts-de-France's administration within 2 working days and, in any case, before the end of the programme.

Any time off from class without the appropriate justification will be recorded in the certificate issued at the end of the programme. Any 2 recorded unjustified absences will result in the non-issuance of the Certificate of completion.

Lateness

Any late arrival in class exceeding half an hour will result in the impossibility to enter the classroom and the participant will be considered as absent.

- Stringently taking the tests that constitute the formative and summative assessment of the training.
- Objectively filling in the satisfaction survey that you will be given at the end of the programme.
- Complying with the internal regulations of the institutions where the training will take place;

In particular, individuals' behaviour, including actions, attitudes, statements, or attire, must not:

- ✓ undermine public order or disrupt the institution's functioning;
- ✓ interfere with teaching, research, administrative, cultural, or authorised activities on-site;
- ✓ breach the principle of secularism in public higher education;
- compromise the health, hygiene, or safety of individuals and property (accordingly, you may be required to wear appropriate attire for certain science-related activities);

In general, all behaviour must demonstrate respect, civility, and compliance with applicable laws.
